



## With A Strong Hand & An Outstretched Arm Exodus 6

### Objective:

Recognize the strong hand that took us out from the bondage of sin and the outstretched arm that has made us His people and has brought us into His land.

### Verse to memorize:

"I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I *am* the Lord your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians." **Exodus 6:7**

### Mercy

1) I \_\_\_\_\_ from under the burdens of the Egyptians, <Bring us out>

2) I \_\_\_\_\_ from their bondage, <Remain free>

3) I \_\_\_\_\_ with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. <Purchase us>

### Grace

4) I \_\_\_\_\_ as My people <Adopt us>

5) \_\_\_\_\_ your God. Then you shall know that I *am* the Lord your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. <Give us identity>

6) I \_\_\_\_\_ into the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; <Have communion>

7) and I \_\_\_\_\_ as a heritage: <Give us Inheritance>

The seven promises of God to His people were based on His Grace without any human merit or requirement. He doesn't even mention that He will give them a law that they must follow or celebrations that they must keep. He only shows us in detail the Gospel of Grace prepared in Christ Jesus.
